maximize your disposable cash. However it also increases the chance of paying unintended fees and interest due to forgotten unpaid bills. According to CNN Money website (1), "in one poll, nearly 25% of respondents admitted they had lost or forgotten about a key financial document; only 40% thought they could find needed paperwork at a moment's notice."
